

## FASHION FOR GOOD THE LOCATION

**Fashion for Good** is housed in a historic building in the heart of Amsterdam's city centre. The international hub for sustainability, fashion and innovation offers bright, inspiring spaces suitable for a variety of uses, large groups as well as intimate gatherings. Easily accessible by public transport, the location is perfectly suited to host local as well as international get togethers and provides a dedicated capacity ranging from 5 to 150 guests.

> Built in 1903 and preserved as a national monument, this historic building was originally an all mens reading museum. When visiting, you can still find the 'Gebouw Leesmuseum' plaque on the building's facade.

The spacious BALLROOM can be outfitted to be used for presentations, screenings, hackathons or seated dining.

The adjacent BAR provides for a social area to receive guests, where beverages, snacks, light meals and the occasional cocktail can be served. GOOD BASE can also be used for more intimate network gatherings or workshops.

Additionally, meeting rooms are available should an event require more spaces for breakout sessions or a quiet spot to work in seclusion.





## MEETING SPACES




The building offers four meeting rooms of varying capacity, ranging from spaces for more personal one-on-one sessions to larger, group meetings. These meeting rooms can be found throughout the building and can be booked independently from the event spaces.
